Speciality Registrars in Haematology and Transfusion Medicine, about to take the data interpretation section of the RCPATH examination. Delegates must have an StR number

Length of the programme:

One week (5 day) block

To get the most out of this programme the attendee should:

- All candidates are expected to have attended an Intermediate Transfusion Medicine programme.
- Have read the relevant recommended material as well as BCSH Transfusion Guidelines

The aim of the programme is:

To prepare candidates for the data interpretation part (Part II) of the RCPATH examination

By the end of the programme you should be able to:

Apply transfusion medicine / science knowledge and interpret results across a range of practical / clinical situations in order to satisfactorily complete the data interpretation part of the RCPATH examination in Haematology and Transfusion Medicine

The programme covers the following topics (indicative content):

A variety of clinical scenarios, case studies, data interpretation, tutorials and mock examination questions to prepare candidates for their RCPATH examination in Transfusion Medicine. This is an examination orientated revision course
