New Functionality

New User Profile

Version 8.1.3 now includes a new user profile. The Reconciliation user profile will limit the user to reconciling orders only. These users will be unable to create and submit orders for components.

OBOS Reconciliation glitch fixed

During the pilot for OBOS Reconciliation we discovered a glitch when confirming orders that were delivered in the early hours of the morning. The problem has now been located and will be fixed with the release of version 8.1.3.

Sickle Cell Patient

Following on from feedback, version 8.1.3 has been developed to automatically tick the HbS- box when the sickle cell patient option is ticked. It will not be possible to untick the HbS- box whilst the sickle cell box is ticked. Once the sickle cell box is unticked it will be possible to untick the HbS- box but this will not occur automatically.

Reminders

Computer Mouse Wheel

The normal functionality of the computer mouse scroll wheel varies slightly depending on which internet browser version you are using. It is important that you do not inadvertently change a selection for any of the drop-down menus using the mouse scroll wheel – **check all selections before selecting “Send order”**.

Active Accounts

You should deactivate any user accounts when the user moves out of a hospital/Trust they no longer need to order products for. This will remove the possibility of accessing the wrong account and placing orders for the wrong location.
